ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN THEORETICAL CONDENSED MATTER PHYSICS AT NORDITA

Nordita, the Nordic Institute for Theoretical Physics, invites applications for an assistant professor position in theoretical condensed matter physics, starting in September 2012 or at some other date to be agreed upon.

The application deadline is

November 22, 2011.

Only online applications will be accepted. The application procedure is posted at jam.nordita.org.

The appointment will be for a period of **five years**. Particular attention will be paid to applications from young scientists (PhD within the last five years) with a strong record of original research.

The successful applicant is expected to guide fellows at the postdoctoral level, to interact with colleagues at Nordita and its environment as well as elsewhere in the Nordic countries, and to take an active part in the organization of meetings and advanced courses. The position provides excellent opportunities to pursue original research and to be in contact with a wide range of developments in theoretical physics. There is good support for travel to other institutes and to meetings, and assistant professors are encouraged to invite visiting scientists to Nordita.

Nordita was founded in 1957 in Copenhagen, Denmark, but was relocated to the AlbaNova University Center in Stockholm, Sweden, in January 2007 where it is jointly hosted by Stockholm University and the Royal Institute of Technology (KTH). Research at Nordita covers a wide range of modern theoretical physics. The research activity of the local staff is supplemented by Nordita scientific programs, which bring together groups of leading experts to work on specific topics for extended periods. There is ample opportunity for collaboration with faculty and research staff at the local universities on research projects, co-supervising graduate students, organizing joint seminars and colloquia, and more.
